Editor for the Journal of the American Pomological Society

DESCRIPTION

The function of the Journal is to present peer-reviewed papers on aspects of fruit and nut crops, including production, new fruit cultivars, pest and postharvest aspects, physiology, economics, genetics, and short reviews. The journal is published by a small non-profit society and consists of four volumes per year, with 5-6 manuscripts per volume. Submissions consist of about 30 manuscripts per year.

DUTIES

The editor receives manuscripts, sends them to reviewers, compiles reviewer comments, and guides approved manuscripts through the publishing process. The editor also submits materials for each issue to a commercial printer and sends proofs to authors for review. A yearly report to the APS board that covers the number of manuscripts received/published, editorial challenges and successes, and suggested changes is required.

The review of applications will begin on May 1st, 2024. The application process will remain open until filled.
